#### **IFA - 2007 Kyoto Congress - Branch Reporters**

The Scientific Committee of SAFA has received details of the two main subjects to be dealt with at the 2007 IFA Congress, which is to be held in Kyoto, Japan. The subjects to be dealt with are:

Subject 1: Transfer pricing and Intangibles

Subject 2: Treaty entitlement and the personal attribution of income

The Branch Reporters report into a General Reporter, for each subject. The General Reporters are: Subject 1 - Mr Toshio Miyatake (Japan) and Subject 2 - Mrs Joanna Wheeler (UK/Netherlands).

The responsibility of the Branch Reporter is to prepare a Branch Report, based on guidelines to be set by the General Reporter. The Branch Reports must be delivered to the General Reporters by 15 October 2006. The reports will then form part of the papers for the 2007 Kyoto Congress, and will be published in the printed version of the 2007 IFA Cahiers, and made available electronically.

The Branch Reporters will be encouraged to attend, if at all possible, the briefing meetings to be held during the 2005 Buenos Aires and 2006 Amsterdam Congresses. In case a Branch Reporter is not be in a position to attend the briefing meetings a deputy should be selected who should be fully briefed.
